

HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

- Ancient Methods: Early attempts at cleaning garments without water can be traced back to ancient civilizations. Romans, for example, used various solvents like ammonia and fuller's earth to clean fabrics.
- 2. Early Chemical Solvents: In the 17th and 18th centuries, people began using substances like turpentine and kerosene to spot-clean garments. However, these methods were often hazardous and had limited success.
- 3. French Innovation: The origins o modern dry cleaning are often credited to Jean-Baptiste Jolly, a French dye-works owner, in the mid-19th century. In the 1840s, he noticed that a kerosene spill on a tablecloth no only cleaned the cloth but also left it surprisingly unharmed. This discovery led to the development o a new cleaning process using kerosene.
- 4. Expansion o the Process: The idea o using non-water-based solvents for cleaning gained popularity in the 19th century. Other entrepreneurs, such as the Frenchman Achille Serre and the American Thomas Jennings, contributed to the refinement o the process. Jennings, in 1821, became the first African American to receive a patent for his dry cleaning process.
- **5.** Introduction o Commercial Dry Cleaning: The first modern dry cleaning shop is often credited to Jolly, who opened an establishment in Paris in the mid-19th century. The process spread to other pars o Europe and the United States.
- 6. Water-Based Solvents: While dry cleaning traditionally involved non water-based solvents like kerosene, the 20th century saw a resurgence o water-based solvents, such as soaps and detergents. These water-based methods, also known as "wet cleaning," gained popularity as advancements in technology and fabric care improved.
- 7. Perchloroethylene (Perc) Era: In the early to mid-20th century, the cleaning industry witnessed a major shift with the introduction o perchloroethylene, a synthetic solvent that became the standard for dry cleaning due to its effectiveness and relative safety.
- 8. Advancements and Environmental Concerns: While perchloroethylene remained widely used for decades, concerns about its environmental impact and health risks led to the development o alternative solvents and processes in the late 20th century. Newer methods, including water-based and more environmentally friendly solvents, have gained popularity.

Today, dry cleaning includes boh traditional solvent-based methods and more modern water-based alternatives, offering consumers a range of choices based on fabric types, environmental considerations, and cleaning preferences. The industry continues to evolve towards sustainable and eco-friendly practices.
